**ORDER**

This matter comes before the Court on the Parties' Second Consent Motion to Modify Subpoena Response Schedule for Non-Party PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (the "Motion). (ECF No. 165.) On December 21, 2020, the Court issued an Order requiring PJM, in response to Defendants' subpoena, to "produce its responsive documents on or before February 26, 2021." (Dec. 21, 2020 Order, ECF No. 162.) On March 1, 2021, the Court granted the Parties' first Consent Motion to Modify Subpoena Response Schedule for Non-Party PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. ("PJM"), extending "the deadline for PJM to produce responsive documents to March 12, 2021." (Mar. 1, 2021 Order, ECF No. 164.)

In the Motion, the Parties jointly request the Court "to extend the deadline for PJM to produce responsive documents to March 24, 2021, to allow the parties to reach an agreement about a proposed protective order." (Mot. 1, ECF No. 165.) The Parties inform that "PJM agrees that it will agree to continue to work toward completing production, if additional follow up is needed, until the end of written discovery on April 23, 2021." (*Id.*) The Parties also state

that “PJM further agrees that it will not object should defendants or FERC seek leave of court to extend the document production schedule.” (*Id.*)

For good cause shown and based on the Parties’ agreement, the Court GRANTS the Motion. PJM SHALL produce responsive documents no later than March 24, 2021.
