Enclosed are redacted documents responsive to your October 2, 2013 request (FY14-1), filed pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552 (2012) and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (Commission or FERC) regulations, specifically 18 C.F.R. § 388.108. You requested various documents related to a job posting to fill the position of the Director of the Office of Enforcement. The Commission withheld all responsive documents in an October 31, 2013 determination and your subsequent appeal of that determination was denied.

You filed a complaint on March 25, 2014 in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia seeking responsive documents. On April 30, 2014, the Judge extended the time period for the Commission to respond to the complaint until June 19, 2014. In advance of filing the answer to the complaint later today, the Agency is making a discretionary release of responsive documents.
